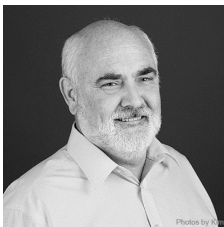
MACKENZIE RECOGNIZES DENNIS WOODS AND DAVE LARSON AS PRINCIPALS
